OUR CANADIAN ROCKIES BY RAIL ITINERARY OF ADVENTURE

DAY 1 - MONDAY - JUNE 18, 2012

A private motorcoach whisks us off to Chicago's O'Hare Airport for a late morning flight westward. By noon we are arriving in British Columbia, where a local guide invites us to not only see Vancouver, but to taste it as well, on an incredible street food adventure. Our tour, called "Eat Your Cart Out", lets us experience the best of local "street meat", indulge in international culinary creations, as well as sample some good ol' fashioned Canadian Classics. Late afternoon sees us crossing the bridge to Granville Island. An eclectic mix of shops, boutiques and galleries, Granville Island is perhaps most famous for its large and bustling Public Market, where local farmers and artisans peddle their wares. Our enchanting hotel, nestled on the banks of False Creek, overlooking the waterfront and beautiful downtown Vancouver is one of the city's best kept secrets. This evening gather with fellow travelers for an amazing view from the Docksider Restaurant where a casually elegant, dinner party is held in our honor.

DAY 2 - TUESDAY - JUNE 19, 2012

Spend the morning exploring Granville Island, an urban oasis filled with fine waterfront restaurants, theatres, galleries, studios, unique shops, cafes and the most spectacular fresh food market you've ever seen. This afternoon, we're off to discover Vancouver's other highlights. It begins at Stanley Park, a thousand acre wonderland that is home to native carved Totem Poles and a Coastal Red Cedar Forest. Then, as evening approaches we'll wend our way to historic Gastown, Vancouver's oldest neighborhood and a registered national historic site. Stroll down its cobblestoned streets, past grand Victorian Buildings, into hidden courtyards and mews, to find some of the trendiest shops, and cafes in the city. It is in one of these that we'll enjoy a "Bon Voyage" Pasta Party. Then the whistle blows, and it's "All Aboard!" Via Rail's famed *Canadian*, a premier train that travels from the Pacific west to the mountains of Alberta. Nestle into your private sleeping compartment and let the rails gently rock you to sleep.

DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY - JUNE 20, 2012

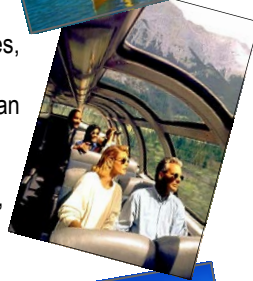
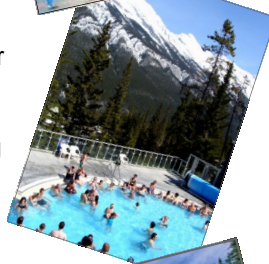

Wake up to the spectacular scenery of the Canadian Rockies. It is passing by the large picture window in your private rail compartment! Meander down to the Dining Car and enjoy a hot cooked breakfast. Then you might decide to join fellow Classic Club travelers in the Domed Observation Car, reserved exclusively for Sleeper Touring Class Passengers. As we climb higher into the majestic Canadian Rockies, we'll leave British Columbia behind and enter the amazing province of Alberta. Some of the countless highlights in store for you today include Mount Robson, (at 12,972 feet, it is the tallest peak in the Canadian Rockies); Pyramid Falls and the climb over Yellowhead Pass into Jasper National Park. Mid-day you're invited to lunch in the Dining Car and the afternoon continues with more incredible vistas; hanging glaciers, alpine lakes, mile-high meadows. By early evening, it is time to bid the *Canadian* a fond farewell, walk across the street from the Jasper Rail Station and check-in to our home for the next two nights, Whistler's Inn. Situated in the heart of Jasper, this comfortable property is within steps of restaurants, shops, and entertainment. The hotel boasts a roof-top Jacuzzi, two on site restaurants, and was totally renovated in 2009. The evening is yours to explore this enchanting mountain village.

DAY 4 - THURSDAY - JUNE 21, 2012

After a hot cooked breakfast in Cassio's Restaurant, our morning begins with a gorgeous, potentially wildlife-filled drive from the town site of Jasper to Maligne Lake. It is here that we board our 90 minute scenic cruise to Spirit Island, an excursion that has been crowned as the "Best Boat Tour in Canada" by 8 million Reader's Digest subscribers. Upon our return, a "Steak by the Lake" Barbeque has been arranged for Classic Club Travelers. Circumstances permitting, we'll enjoy this feast in the original Maligne Lake Chateau, a fully restored 1927 rustic log building that offers unimpeded and spectacular panoramas of Maligne Lake. This day of stunning surprises continues with an afternoon visit to Maligne Canyon, one of the area's most spectacular landmarks. Eroded by the fast flowing Maligne River for thousands of years, it is only three feet across in some places, but over 200 feet deep. You will have time to explore the Interpretive Trail with several bridges which follows the canyon as it courses towards



the Athabasca River. On our return to Jasper we'll see Pyramid Lake and Patricia Lake. Then the evening is yours. Take advantage of our hotel's fabulous location to explore the charms of this alpine hamlet.

DAY 5 - FRIDAY - JUNE 22, 2012

Athabasca Falls are among the most powerful and breathtaking falls in the Rocky Mountains. This will be the first stop on our spectacular day of sightseeing. Next we embark on a trek south along the famed Icefields Parkway. Winding along the shoulder of the Great Divide it is considered one of the most scenic highways in the world. Ultimately we'll arrive at the Columbia Icefields, home to the "Ice Age Adventure", where massive specially designed Ice Explorers take us onto the slopes of the glacier. At mid-point in this tour we can step out onto ice, over a thousand feet deep, formed from snow falling as long as 400 years ago. At the Columbia Icefields, we'll take a group photo, and each traveler will receive their own 5"x7" picture souvenir. A filling buffet beckons at the Columbia Icefields Restaurant and we'll fill up on delicious specialties before continuing to spectacular Lake Louise. Framed by an emerald lake, ringed with snow-capped peaks and tucked into a fragrant alpine meadow, this fairy-tale spot epitomizes the splendor and enchantment of Canada's Rocky Mountain Range. By early evening we are wending our way into Banff, known for the healing waters of its natural springs. Once checked into our charming hotel, we'll join those, who for more than a century have come to "take the waters". Relax with fellow Classic Club travelers in the outdoor, mineral spring fed, hot pool while soaking up views of famous Mount Rundle.

DAY 6 - SATURDAY - JUNE 23, 2012

A Continental breakfast begins the day, then we are off to explore the awe and wonder of Yoho National Park. Here in the shadow of the Great Divide are towering walls of rock, thundering waterfalls and 28 peaks over 10,000 feet high. Built into the sheer rock of Cathedral Mountain are the Spiral Tunnels, an engineering marvel that ranks as one of the Seven Wonders of Canada. After a stop at this viewpoint, we'll continue on to Emerald Lake and the impressive Kicking Horse River. Water and time have relentlessly worn through solid bedrock to create a natural rock bridge over this rollicking river. As lunch-time approaches we find ourselves in the mountain village of Field. A tight-knit family community of fewer than 200 people, there are still two rustic dining outlets and about six specialty shops to lure the adventurous traveler. This evening, back in Banff, a special event beckons. It all starts at our "Meet a Mountie" Reception, where the guest of honor will be a retired Canadian Mounted Policeman, in full uniform. This reception is followed by a three course feast of Canadian delicacies.

DAY 7 - SUNDAY - JUNE 24, 2012

Begin the day with a Continental Breakfast, then make the most of your morning, exploring the delightful village of Banff. In the afternoon, we'll climb to heights of nearly 7500 feet when we take the Banff Gondola to the summit of Sulphur Mountain. Our modern, fully-enclosed four-passenger gondola cabins will transport us to the Upper Terminal where we have a bird's eye view of six different mountain ranges. Atop this pinnacle sits the Regal View Garden Restaurant which hosts a Farewell Buffet Luncheon for Classic Club travelers, amid breathtaking views of the Canadian Rockies. As we leave Banff late this afternoon, we'll travel through the Bow Valley and make a stop at Bow Falls, a short, wide robust stretch of water that was featured in the 1954 movie, "River of No Return". This evening we'll arrive in Calgary and check-in to the Superior Class Delta Calgary Hotel, where our reserved, Premier Rooms await. The hotel is connected by an indoor walkway to the Calgary International Airport, which optimizes the time we have before our flight tomorrow morning.

DAY 8 - WEDNESDAY - JUNE 25, 2012

Porters walk us from our deluxe in-airport hotel, right to the flight check-in counter. Soon we are jetting towards Chicago on a direct non-stop flight. At O'Hare Airport a private motorcoach will be standing by to return us to Geneseo, where the memories of this incredible trek through the magnificent Canadian Rockies will be ours to cherish forever.
