# CLUB INFORMATION

#### REAL ID UPDATE

You now have until May 7, 2025 to obtain a Real ID designation on your drivers license. This will be required for adults traveling on U.S. commercial flights or upon entering certain federal buildings. The U.S. Department of Homeland Security recently announced it has extended the previous deadline to get the new identification card. You now have until May 7, 2025. Those who do not have a Real ID designation on their license by the May 2025 deadline will be required to use another acceptable form of identification, such as a passport, to board a flight, or enter federal buildings. #### Deposit Reservation Requirements:

A \$20.00 deposit is required for each Classic Club day trip. Extended travel deposit requirements will be printed on each trip flyer and will vary depending on each tour. Reservations will not be confirmed until deposit requirements have been met.

#### Liability Waiver:

All members and member guests MUST have a signed liability waiver to travel with Classic Club. Waivers are available at all Central Bank locations.

#### Cancellation Policy:

If a cancellation is necessary, every effort will be made to provide either a partial or full refund. Usually you can transfer your space and payment to a friend or relative. Also, if we have a waiting list, we will do all we can to fill your space and provide a refund. We cannot guarantee a refund. There will be times when refunds will not be possible due to ticket purchases, meal guarantees, no waiting list, etc. If a tour cancels because of insufficient reservations, you will receive a full refund. On tours where an outside agent is used, we will adhere to the written cancellation policy of the agent.

Important! There will now be a 4% fee for Credit Card charges processed by Classic Club for tour payments. Each tour differs and some payments/charges do not apply.
